Chapter 19

- 16 – Someone: Teacher, what good deed must I do to have eternal life?
- 17 – Jesus: Keep the commandments
- 20 - Young man: I have kept all these; what do I still lack?
- 21 – Jesus: If you wish to be perfect, go, sell your possessions, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me
- 22 – The young man went away grieving, for he had many possessions

- 23 – It will be hard for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven
- 24 – It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle
- 25 – The disciples were greatly astounded – Then who can be saved?
- 26 – For mortals it is impossible, but for God all things are possible
- 27 – Peter: We have left everything and followed you; what then will we have?

Chapter 20

- 1 – The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard
- 2 – After agreeing with the laborers for the usual daily wage
- 3-7 – He went out again about 9 AM, 12 noon, 3 PM, and 5 PM
- 9 – Those hired about 5 PM each received the usual daily wage
- 10 – The first thought they would receive more
- 11 – They grumbled
- 13 – Friend, I am doing you no wrong
- 15 – Are you envious because I am generous?

- 20 – The mother of the sons of Zebedee asked a favor of Him
- 22 – Jesus: You do not know what you are asking
- 24 - The ten were angry with the two brothers
- 26 – It will not be so among you; whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant
- 28 – The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve

- 29-30 – As they were leaving Jericho, there were two blind men sitting by the roadside
- 30 – Blind men: Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David
- 31 – The crowd sternly ordered them to be quiet, but they shouted even more loudly
- 32 – Jesus stood still and called them - What do you want me to do for you?
- 33 – Blind men: Lord, let our eyes be opened
- 34 – Immediately they regained their sight and followed Him

Chapter 21

2 – Immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her; untie them and bring them

3 – Say, The Lord needs them, and he will send them immediately

4 – This took place to fulfill what had been spoken through the prophet

12 – Jesus entered the temple and drove out all who were selling and buying in the temple

14 – The blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He cured them

15 – When the chief priests and scribes saw the amazing things that He did, and heard the children crying out in the temple, they became angry

19 – A fig tree by the side of the road – nothing but leaves – it withered at once

21 – Jesus: If you have faith and do not doubt, not only will you do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain

23 – Chief priests and elders of the people: By what authority are you doing these things, and who gave you this authority?

24 – Jesus: If you answer My question, then I will answer yours

25 – Jesus: Did the baptism of John come from heaven, or was it of human origin?

45 – The chief priests and Pharisees realized He was speaking about them

46 – They wanted to arrest Him, but they feared the crowds

Chapter 22

2 – The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son

8 – The wedding is ready, but those invited were not worthy

9 – Go therefore and invite everyone you find to the wedding banquet

10 – So the wedding hall was filled with guests – God wants heaven to be full!

15-16 – The Pharisees plotted to entrap Him - they sent their disciples along with the Herodians

17 – Is it lawful to pay taxes to the emperor?

22 – When they heard this, they were amazed; and they left Him and went away

23 – Some Sadducees came to Him, saying there is no resurrection

28 – In the resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be?

29 – You know neither the scriptures nor the power of God

32 – He is God not of the dead, but of the living (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob)

33 – When the crowd heard it, they were astounded at His teaching

34 – When the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together

45 – If David calls (the Messiah) Lord, how can he be his son?

46 – No one was able to give Him an answer, nor from that day did anyone dare to ask Him any more questions
