All are welcome! Sign-up sheets in the Narthex.

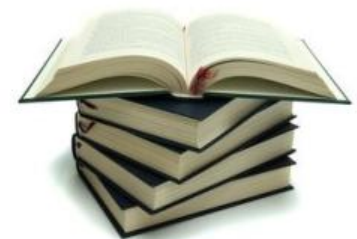
## Living Water Scholarship Proposal

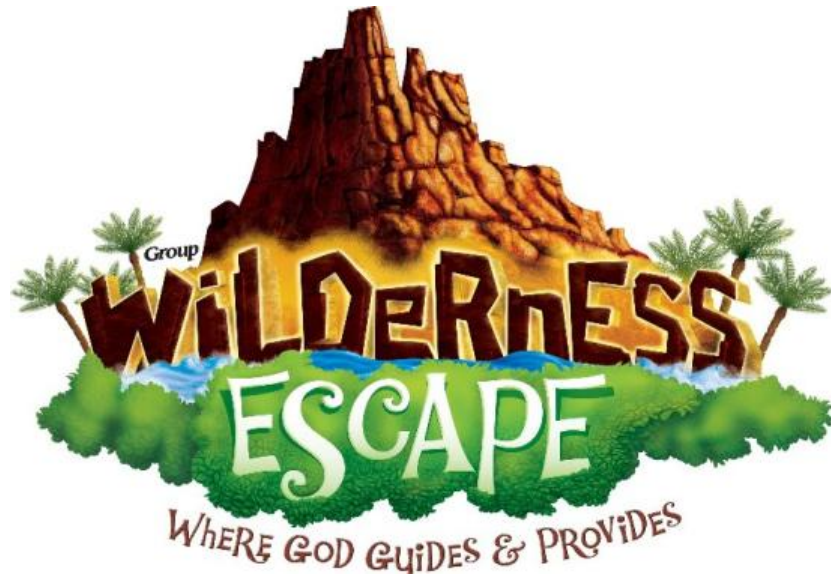
## Adult Forums for Jan 12 and 19 “Ask the Pastors”

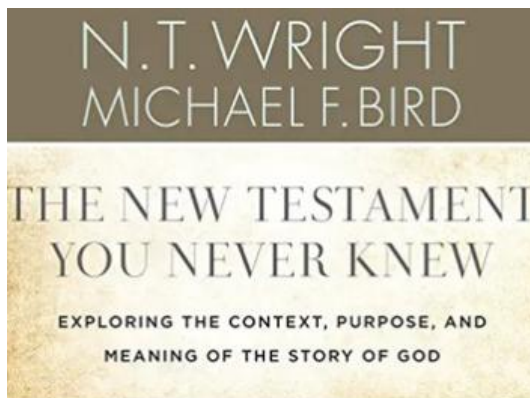


## **MEN'S BREAKFAST BIBLE STUDY 2020**
