Tuesday Women Returns on September 8th – 10 am

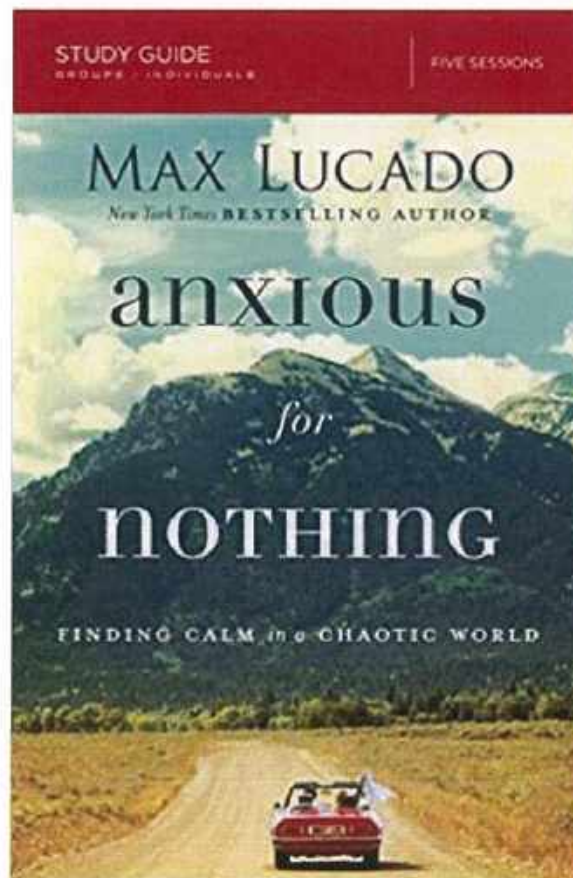
The Tuesday Women's Bible study will resume on **Tuesday morning, Sept. 8th, at 10 am** in a virtual environment – that means **via Zoom!**
